**Complaint against Professor Kukjin Chun, IEEE Region 10 Director**

I refer to your latest letter dated 1 June 2018 and my numerous correspondences since 2016 and recent complaint letters against you, concerning about the reason behind your illegal suspension of the elected HK Section Officers and appointment of Interim Hong Kong Section Officers. In the above-mentioned letter, you have not addressed any of my points raised in my complaint letter of 8 May 2018 to you but only the following groundless statement:-

*“The decision to suspend you, pursuant to Section 9.4.F.10 of the IEEE Member and Geographic Activities (MGA) Operations Manual, from the positions of Chairman of the IEEE Hong Kong Section, Newsletter Editor, and Student Branch Counselor at the University of Hong Kong, was made based on the absence of any Section elections since early 2016. As a result, the Section did not conduct elections within the term stipulated by IEEE policies and your term of office expired. The interim team has been requested to conduct new elections.”*

It is extremely disappointing to learn that your letter only proves that you, as the Region 10 Direction, are abusing of your power illegally. For the record, there is one and only Section election in the past 46 years since HK Section’s inception in 1972. The only Section election ever held was in 2016 to decide the Chair-elect post of HK Section, in which I won the election as Chair-elect and Mr. YW Liu, a good friend of you, lost that election. So your reason of suspension and appointment of Interim Hong Kong Section Officers is completely unjustified other than covering-up and stopping my complaint to you as a whistle-blower about illegal and criminal activities. You and the illegal appointees are acting in concerts in retaliating me, the whistle-blower, and damaging my reputation and professionalism in front of all the IEEE members in Region 10. **As a result, I demand you to retract the letter of 4 May 2018 and an apology from you within 7 days. I hereby reserve my right to take further actions against you and the illegal appointees on this matter for the damages to me.**

Moreover, I am still awaiting your urgent reply to the questions/points raised in my letter of 8 May 2018.
