Section activities:

Chairman's report

1. Society Registration Problem

- As of today, no Section document was ever handed over from holders of the documents of HK Section.
- In March 2017, Hong Kong (HK) Section filed with the Hong Kong Police according to the Societies Ordinance Cap. 151. HK Section was then asked to produce the Original Copy of the Registration Certificate to complete the procedure.
- The Industrial Center of the Polytechnic University (PolyU) has been for many years and is still the registered address of Hong Kong Section. Mr Edward YH Cheung, a self-proclaimed 2016 Section Executive Committee Member, and Mr YW Liu, the resigned Interim 2016 Section Treasurer, are still supposed to be keeping all the HK Section documents in the registered Section Office. HK Section wrote to ask Mr Edward YH Cheung many times to return the Original Copy of the Registration Certificate and all other section documents to HK Section. However, Mr Edward YH Cheung only replied recently that no section document was kept in the Industrial Center of the PolyU.
- As a result, we had reported to the Police the loss of the Original Certificate in PolyU in June and we were expecting to receive the new Certificate soon. However, as of today, we still have not received it.
- It is learned from the Registration Office of Police Department that Mr YW Liu, the resigned Interim 2016 Section Treasurer, is causing delays of the process. So we still have not received the new Certificate.

2. Section Finance Problems

- As of today, HK Section still has not recovered control of the Section bank accounts, and so still cannot make payments to operate Section activities and reimburse claims to chapters which have all their money in the Section's centralized account.
- As of today, Mr YW Liu, the resigned interim Section Treasurer 2016, still has not disclosed the authorized signatories of the Section's Bank accounts. HK Section still does not know who the authorized signatory persons of the Section's bank accounts are. HK Section has not seen any bank statements. HK Section does not know if the money is still in those bank accounts.
- In June, Prof Kukjin Chun, 2017 Region 10 Director, asked HK Section to produce the Audit of 2016 HK Section books. As of today, Mr YW Liu is still refusing to handover any reimbursement claim forms, claimed receipts or ledgers, and bank statements to HK Section, it is impossible to do any audit with no documents.

3. HK Section Documents and Website problems

- Mr Edward YH Cheung is still refusing to handover the Website domain name back to HK Section. As HK Section has not received the new Certificate to recover control of the Section bank accounts for operation expenses, HK Section does not have an official website domain to serve IEEE members.
- Mr Edward YH Cheung self-proclaimed as holding a post of External Liaison Coordinator in the 2016 HK Section Executive Committee (ExCom). In reality, according to IEEE HQ database, there is no such post as "External Liaison Coordinator" in Hong Kong Section ExCom. He ceased to be an ExCom member immediately when he stepped down as a Chapter Chair in AGM 2014 (i.e. January 2015). Subsequently, he simply put his name as an ExCom member on Hong Kong Section Web Site under his control.

4. Voter registration in the ITFC 2017

- The Registration and Electoral Office (REO) of HKSAR is reviewing the eligibility of two Chapters' members as ITFC electors/voters for registration: (1) the Computer Chapter and (2) the

Joint Chapter on Circuits and Systems/Communications.

- These two chapters have direct access to their own chapters' membership information in the USA database, which was requested by REO for voters registration reviews.
- Both chapters did not provide the information requested by REO for voters registration reviews.
- Upon receipt of complaints from members, Computer Chapter finally provided REO with some information for voters registration reviews.
- It should be noted that when forming a special IEEE interest group/Chapter, each Chapter must obtain its own Charter directly from the IEEE Head Quarters of USA. Each Chapter has full autonomy to handle special interests for its own Chapter members. All chapter chairs have direct access to their own chapters' membership information in the USA database.
- Both Computer Chapter and Joint Chapter on Circuits and Systems/Communications have not updated the status of their chapters about whether they have held their AGM2016 or its Officers Nominations of 2017. According to the USA record, these chapters were inactive in 2016.
- **It should also be noted that, as IEEE USA and IEEE HK Section are always politically neutral, chapter chairs should be responsible to communicate with REO for political interests of their own chapters.**

IEEE TALE2017 will be held 12-14 December 2017, The Education University of Hong Kong, Tai Po, Hong Kong.



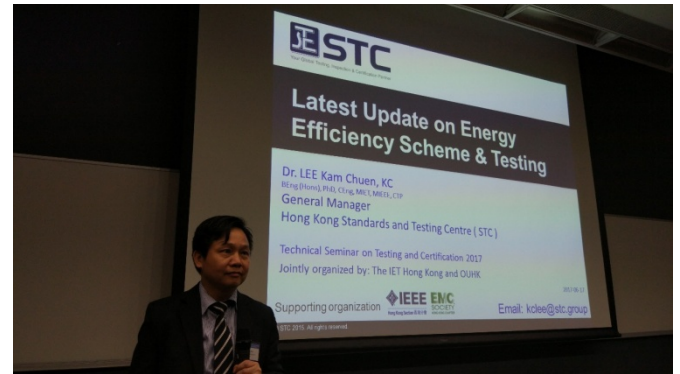
