Section activities:

Chairman's report

- **1. Section finance problems** (update in May 2017)
 - Hong Kong (HK) Section still has not recovered control of the Section bank accounts.
 - Mr YW Liu, resigned Interim Treasurer 2016, is still refusing to handover the any reimbursement claim forms, claimed receipts or ledgers to HK Section. He still has not disclosed the authorized signatories of the Section's Bank accounts for HK Section to conduct internal audit.
 - HK Section still cannot make payments to operate Section activities and reimburse claims to chapters which have all their money in the Section's centralized account.

2. HK Section Documents and Website problems (update in May 2017)

- Mr Edward YH Cheung, a self-proclaimed 2016 Section Executive Committee Member who has control of the HK Section Website domain name, is still refusing to handover the Website domain name back to HK Section. So HK Section still cannot have an official website domain to serve IEEE members.
- Mr Edward YH Cheung and Mr YW Liu are still keeping all the HK Section documents in the Section Office in Industry Centre of Hong Kong Polytechnic University.

3. Vote-rigging in the ITFC and ICAC (update in May 2017)

- HK Section has reported the incident to Region-10 Director, IEEE President and IEEE Chair-elect.
- In March, the Hong Kong Independent Commission Against Corruption (HKICAC) arrested 72 persons for allegedly engaging

in corrupt conduct of vote-rigging in the Information Technology **Functional** Constituency (ITFC) of the 2016 Legislative Council (LegCo) Election. Most of these persons registered as electors of the ITFC through their memberships with two professional organizations in the information technology (IT) field. According to the ICAC, these arrestees have backgrounds ranging from students, clerks, drivers to housewives, and might not possess the requisite academic qualifications and/or working experience in the IT field to qualify them for membership of the IT professional organizations.

• Since IEEE membership admissions in all countries are handled by the IEEE Headquarters in the USA, HK Section has not been involved in it the past 40 years,

The Hong Kong Council for Testing and Certification (HKCTC) Secretariat had cooperated with Hong Kong Association for Testing, Inspection and Certification (HKTIC) to arrange this series of seminars at the trade fairs.
